#Your Stay in Paris

Transport

NPCs are responsible for their own athletes, guide-runners and any other staff members. The Spartner Agency will take care of ground transfer – persons and equipment – from Paris Train Stations and Paris Airports to the official hotels.

Athletes' Equipment: Any competition equipment (racing chairs, race running and throwing frames) will be directly transported to the equipment storage at the Charlety Stadium (competition venue).

#Sports Information

Entry Registration

Registrations are open to all Athletes licensed by World Para Athletics for the 2024 year.

Entry registrations are open from March 20th 2024 until May, 1st 2024 via SDMS.

Competition Schedule

A preliminary competition schedule will be provided following the final entry deadline – 1st May 2024.

Technical Meeting

The Technical Meeting is scheduled on the 12th of June (Wednesday) at 16:00 at the Charlety stadium.

The NPC/NF representative's attendance is mandatory. Prior to the Technical Meeting, NPC/NFs will receive a final confirmation form to make final changes.

Bibs will be distributed to NPC/NFs at the end of the Technical Meeting, and entries will be considered as final. Start-lists will be produced after the Technical Meeting and displayed/distributed at the competition venue.

#Classification

International classification for Athletes with a New or Review Class status will be conducted prior to the competition. VI classification will take place on the 11th and 12th of June at the hospital of the Salpêtrière. PI and II classification will take place on the 10th, 11th and 12th of June at the Charlety stadium.

There will be 2 panels for Visual Impairment (VI), 3 panels for Physical Impairment (PI) and 1 panel for Intellectual Impairment (II).

Shuttles for VI classification will be organized from the IBIS Paris Porte d'Italie hotel to the Pitié Salpêtrière Hospital where VI classification takes place. Prior to the competition, a shuttle schedule will be sent to the teams attending VI classification. For PI and II classification, teams will be required to make their own way to the Charlety Stadium.

#Medical Services

In addition to emergency services in case of incidents, a medical and paramedical space will be available on the warm-up field during the competition.

Teams will have the opportunity to benefit from medical and physiotherapy treatment at the competition venue by reaching out to the LOC medical team. If these athletes have well-known problems, it is recommended to come with medical files.

If you plan to come with a doctor and/or a team physiotherapist, we highly suggest you contact Mathieu Basset (LOC Medical, Classification and Anti-Doping Manager) at m.basset@wpaparis23.com. You will be then able to have access to the LOC medical area with your own medical team if needed.

Physiotherapy and first aid services will be present at the competition stadium.

In case of medical need at the hotels, teams can contact the Emergency Medical Service (SAMU) by calling 15 in case of emergency or SOS Medecin by calling +33 1 47 07 77 77.

#Anti-doping

Controls will be conducted according to AFLD's (French Agency Doping Controls) anti-doping controls procedures.

#Accreditation

Athletes'/staff's accreditations will be distributed at the competition venue. The LOC will deliver accreditations to the NPCs that have paid their registration fee (200€ per athlete) and packages.

All team members are required to wear their Accreditation Badge at all times to enter the competition venue. They should wear it in a manner that is clearly visible to security staff. An Accreditation Badge is not transferable and only permits entry to the individual for whom it is issued. Misuse of an Accreditation Badge may result in cancellation of accreditation. In case of loss or theft of an Accreditation Badge, please report it immediately to the LOC.
